ACTION PLAN 2021-27 **CMF GENERAL PREFECTURE OF YVM**

During the first meeting of the General Government (GG) of the Congregation from October 25 to 30, 2021, we worked on outlining our plan of action for the new six-year period 2021-27. This outline was reviewed and reworked in other meetings of the GG, as well as personally by each of the Prefects and among the members of the sub-groups known as *grosso modo* "processes."

The Prefecture of YVM is involved in the so-called "first process of congregational transformation" together with the General Prefecture of Apostolate and the Prefecture of Biblical Pastoral ministry and communications.

On December 10, at 1:00 PM in Rome, we met virtually with the leaders and those in charge of YVM from the different Organisms and Missions of the Congregation. The purpose of the meeting was to present the GG's plan of action, so as to incorporate any suggestions and changes that they considered appropriate before returning to the subject at the Council meetings in January 2022; and to consider two new proposals from the Prefect for the effective collaboration of all with the Prefectures. ...
